



Horseback Riding - Scheduling & Rates

The Good Hope Equestrian Training Center (GHETC) offers equestrian English classes to individual with and without disabilities, ages 3.5 & up, across South Florida. Our inclusive programs are tailored to meet your needs and equestrian ambitions. Our goal is to develop 'the thinking and feeling rider' with relaxation, balance, poise and suppleness in both you and your horse. Using the principles of Balanced Seat riding, we help our students build and strengthen the fundamentals of a solid seat, independence of seat from hands, and safe control of the horse. Our 20-acre facility has two riding arenas (sand & grass), various large open riding fields, & a picturesque South Florida setting that will make you feel like you are far away from the hustle and bustle of city life.

Lesson Basics

To start your lessons, you will need to wear long pants and boots or sneakers. You are more than welcome to borrow one of our ASTM approved riding helmets and chaps or you may wish to purchase your own equipment at a local tack shop. Please arrive 15 minutes early so you can get dressed and assist in grooming and tacking up your horse or pony. Horse grooming, tacking up, and an occasional un-mounted lesson are part of the GHETC horsemanship and riding experience.

Scheduling

Our horseback riding program time frame is flexible and we will do everything in our power to accommodate your schedule. The instructors will try to schedule each student at their first choice of time requested. Please contact the office staff so they are aware of your second choice for scheduling, just in case your first choice is not available.

Absences & Tardiness Policy

Please contact the office (305) 258-2838 if you need to miss a lesson so that the instructor may schedule accordingly. A minimum 24 hour notice is required for all lesson cancellations, or full charge will be assessed. If we are experiencing bad weather, we will contact you if we are going to cancel the session. Because we have back to back scheduled lessons, you must arrive on time for your session. If you miss a part of the lesson, because of tardiness you will still be responsible for payment for the scheduled session.

Fee Schedule

Group Lessons:

\$40.00 per hour

Small semi private (two to four riders) per group on our gentle and kind lesson horses. Helmets, chaps and safety stirrups are provided.

(Prepay nine lessons and get your 10th lesson free - \$360.00)

Private Lessons:

\$ 60.00 per hour

All levels will benefit from this one-on-one training, working on complete harmony between horse and rider. Individual riding goals are taken into detailed consideration.

(Prepay nine lessons and get your 10th lesson free - \$540.00)

\$ 40.00 per half an hour

(Prepay nine lessons and get your 10th lesson free - \$360.00)

Horse Show Fees:

Coaching - \$40.00 per day

Use of Horse - \$30.00 per day

Shipping prices vary based on distance and # of horses attending. Minimum is \$30.00 based on full load. Fee varies, and will be split between entrants on the same horse. Please ask before hand if you are unsure.
